Napa Valley Cabernet Program

New to Steltzner Vineyards is our Napa Valley designated Cabernet Sauvignon bottling. In addition we continue to make a Stags Leap District offering which will be available at a later release date. With our long history in the valley we are able to continue to source great quality Cabernet Sauvignon from several other areas.

Steltzner Vineyards & Stags Leap District

Steltzner Vineyards was founded in 1964 when founder Richard Steltzner planted his first Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard. We farmed over 100 acres in the Stags Leap District until 2012. In February 2012 we sold part of the Estate and production facility. We retained the original 30 acre vineyard site located directly below the Stags Leap Palisades. Today we are making wine at Napa Wine Company located in Oakville.

Winemaker Notes:

Our 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from several vineyards in Napa Valley and includes small amounts of declassified wines from our Stags Leap District Estate. Classic notes of cassis, bright red raspberry and well integrated oak.
