## Steltzner Vineyards & Stags Leap District

Steltzner Vineyards is located in the Stags Leap District where we farm 30 acres of Cabernet Sauvignon, along with small amounts of Sangiovese, Malbec and Petit Verdot. Our family has owned this property since 1965. We currently make our wine at Folio Custom Crush and source only grapes from throughout Napa Valley to create our Sauvignon Blanc.

A small 400 case production of Sauvignon Blanc that was produced from the Stanley Vineyard on Big Ranch Road. This is our first wine made from grape to glass from Bob Pepi – our new winemaker for Steltzner Vineyards.

## Tasting Notes:

Vibrant aromas of pear and orange blossom followed by melon and ripe citrus on the pallet.
